1. Information We Collect

We may collect the following types of information:

Personal Information (voluntarily provided):

- Name, email address, phone number, or mailing address
- Information submitted through contact forms, prayer requests, event registrations, or member-only areas
- Donation-related information (processed through third-party giving platforms)

Non-Personal Information (automatically collected):

- Browser type, device type, and operating system

We do **not** sell, rent, or trade your personal information.

3. Online Giving and Third-Party Services

Online donations and some services are processed through trusted third-party platforms. SRMBC does not store or have access to your full payment information.

These third parties have their own privacy policies and security practices. We encourage you to review their policies before providing personal or financial information.

4. Cookies and Tracking Technologies

Our website may use cookies or similar technologies to enhance functionality and understand how visitors use the site. Cookies do not collect personal information unless you choose to provide it.

You may disable cookies through your browser settings; however, some features of the website may not function properly.

5. Media, Livestreams, and Photography

Church services, events, and activities may be photographed or recorded. These images or recordings may be used on our website, social media, or other church communications.

By attending church events or services, you acknowledge and consent to such use unless otherwise stated.

6. Privacy & Security for Members

We understand the importance of protecting information shared by our church members. Member-only content, forms, and communications are intended for authorized use and are handled with care and confidentiality. Access to member areas is limited, and information shared for church purposes is used only to support ministry operations, communication, and pastoral care.

While no online system can guarantee complete security, we take reasonable steps to safeguard member information and encourage members to protect their login credentials and personal information.

We take reasonable measures to protect your information from unauthorized access, misuse, or disclosure. However, no method of transmission over the internet or electronic storage is completely secure.
